## AMENDMENT NO. 13 TO THE PLAN DOCUMENT OF THE SAN DIEGO ELECTRICAL HEALTH AND WELFARE TRUST

The Plan Document of the San Diego Electrical Health & Welfare Trust is hereby amended as of January 1, 2014 as follows:

1. With respect to services required under the Affordable Care Act to be provided to female **Covered Persons** without application of a deductible, co-payment or co-insurance the provision pertaining to "Breastfeeding support, supplies and counseling" is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

**Breastfeeding support, supplies, and counseling:** Pregnant and postpartum women will have access to comprehensive lactation support and counseling from a trained provider, as well as the costs for renting breastfeeding equipment in conjunction with each birth. The maximum amount payable by the **Plan** under this provision for the rental or purchase of a manual or electric breast pump is \$200 and shall be limited to one pump per delivery.

- 2. Item (12) in Section "C" under "Eligible Expenses" is hereby deleted and replaced as follows:
  - (12) For each female **Covered Employee** or **Spouse** or **Dependent** one mammography examination separated by at least 12 months to be payable at 100% without application of a deductible or co-insurance payment subject to a maximum payment of \$500 covering all charges related to the conduction of the examination. However, there will be no cost to the Employee or Spouse if a mammogram examination is performed by Sharp Rees-Stealy under the routine physical examination program covered by the **Plan**;

- 3. <u>SECTION XII., "EXCEPTIONS AND LIMITATIONS"</u> is hereby amended by adding the following new provision:
- (44) All charges related to the performance of a colonoscopy, whether as part of a routine physical examination or due to **medically necessity**, in excess of \$1,000. The term "all charges" shall include all related facility and professional fees. However, there will be no cost to a **Covered Employee** or **Spouse** if a colonoscopy is performed by Sharp Rees-Stealy under the routine physical examination program covered by the **Plan**;

EXCEPT AS HEREIN AMENDED, THE PLAN DOCUMENT OF THE SAN DIEGO ELECTRICAL HEALTH AND WELFARE TRUST SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.
